We are committed to ensuring those working with children and vulnerable adults adopt best practice to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the participants and members of the Club.

We will endeavor to promote the highest standards of care for all by:

- Implementation of the Scottish Gymnastics Health, Safety and Welfare guidelines;

- Adoption of the Scottish Gymnastics guidelines for the Protection of Children and Vulnerable adults;

- Appointment of Child Protection Officers to whom grievances or complaints can be made confidentially. The club's child protection officers can be contacted via their confidential email address: clubcpc@enigmagymnasticsclub.co.uk;

- Ensuring best coaching practice guidelines are followed at all times.

- Promptly dealing with grievances or complaints and in accordance with the grievance procedures;

- Provision of a minimum of two responsible adults present at all training sessions or events.

- Having a zero tolerance level or poor practice, bullying or any potential form of abuse.
