

Our coaches

How does the Club recruit volunteer coaches?

- The Club ensures coaches / helpers have the competence and experience for the role he/she is carrying out. Coaches will not coach beyond their level of qualification unless being supervised by a more experienced coach;
- o All volunteer coaches working with the Club will be safely recruited. They will:
 - Complete a club volunteers application form having been issued and read job description / duties and responsibilities information sheets for the post being applied for
 - Complete SGA self declaration form
 - Submit a Background check (PVG scheme membership)
 - Attend child protection training (SGA recognised)
- The coach / helper will be fully qualified and will keep up to date with current practice;
- The coach / helper will be encouraged to undertake Saltire, Dynamic or Youth Achievement awards in recognition for their volunteering;
- The coach / helper / official will hold insurance cover appropriate to the level the individual requires. Insurance cover will be issued BG membership;
- The coach / helper must carry out coaching duties with reasonable skill and care in accordance with SGA codes of practice and ethics;
- Coaches / helpers will dress appropriate for their role within the Club. They will wear a tracksuit or loose fitting clothing. Trainers should be worn when assembling or dismantling apparatus.
