How can you help us to raise funds for our Club?

50 / 50 Fundraising activity

Incorporated into training fees is an optional £4 fee for 50/50 Club Membership. The money raised from the fundraising Club is split between members and the Club. The club uses this money to help keep the costs of club merchandise down and contributes towards purchasing equipment for gymnasts to use in our classes.

Drawn three times a year each member has a chance of winning half the amount of money in the pot.

If you have not already signed up for this please see our club treasurers, June Cumming and Sheena Cameron, who are more than happy to help you part with £4 per month.

You do not need to be a gymnast who is paying training fees to take part in our 50/50 club. Anyone who is interested in supporting Enigma Gymnastics Club are welcome to take part although they must have an up to date associate membership with us.
